

## Maokong

The aromatic and mellow Tieguanyin tea produced in Muzha is one of the must-have souvenirs of Taipei. Tourists can enjoy tea and gourmet cuisine at numerous teahouses at the famous Maokong. Three routes to explore this area are recommended:

Red cultural area (Zhanghu area): including cultural sites like the Threestone Teapot Museum, the Tea Master Chang Nai-Miao Memorial Hall, and U Theatre's Laochuan Mountain Theater, etc.

Yellow scenic area (Teahouses and old trails area): numerous teahouses along the road will serve as fine spots to enjoy Taipei's night view.

Blue ecosystem area (Caonan area): including the pothole terrain and the Taipei Tea Promotion Center for Tieguanyin and Baozhong tea, etc.






